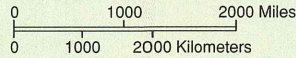

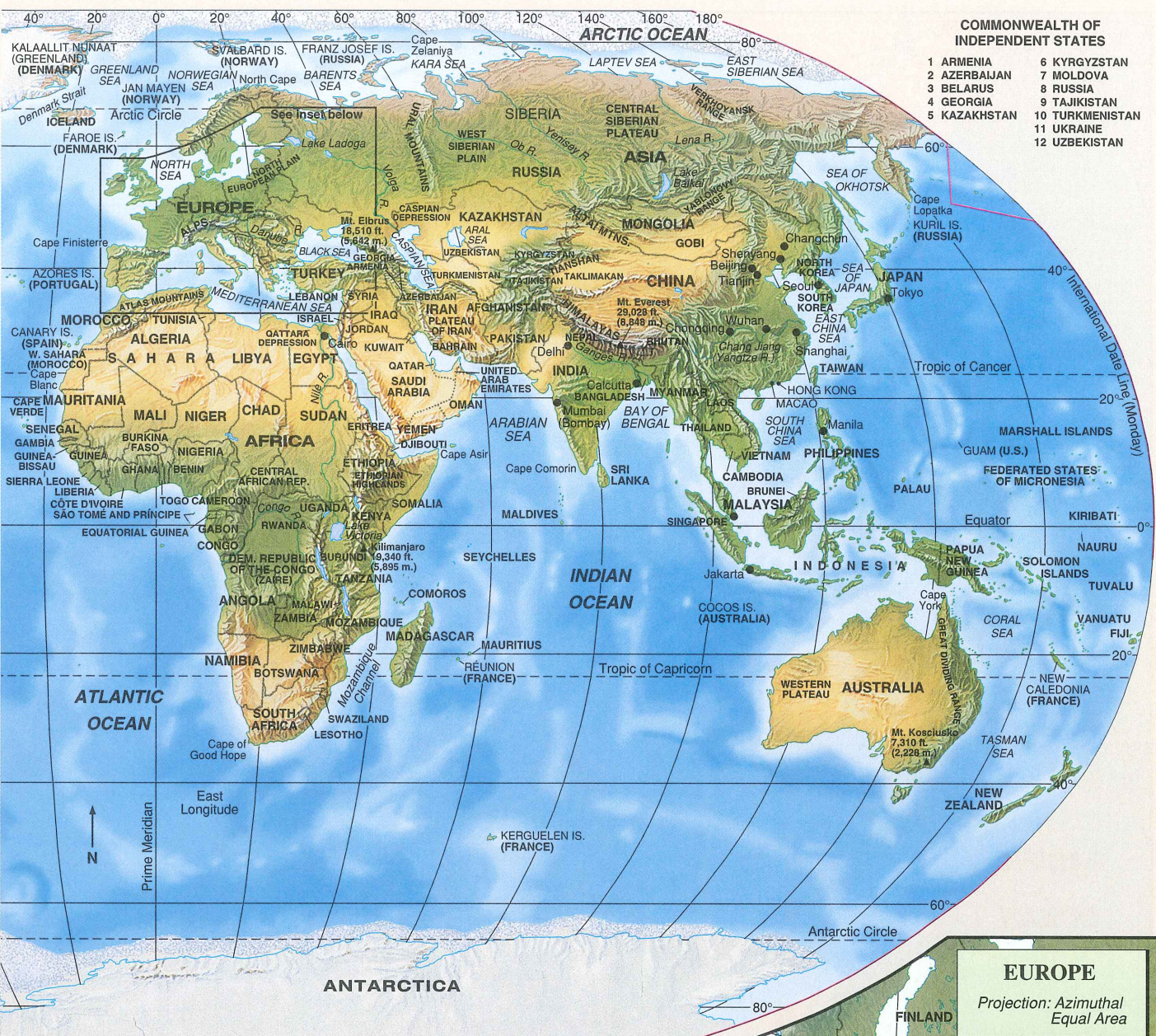

Projection: Azimuthal Equal Area























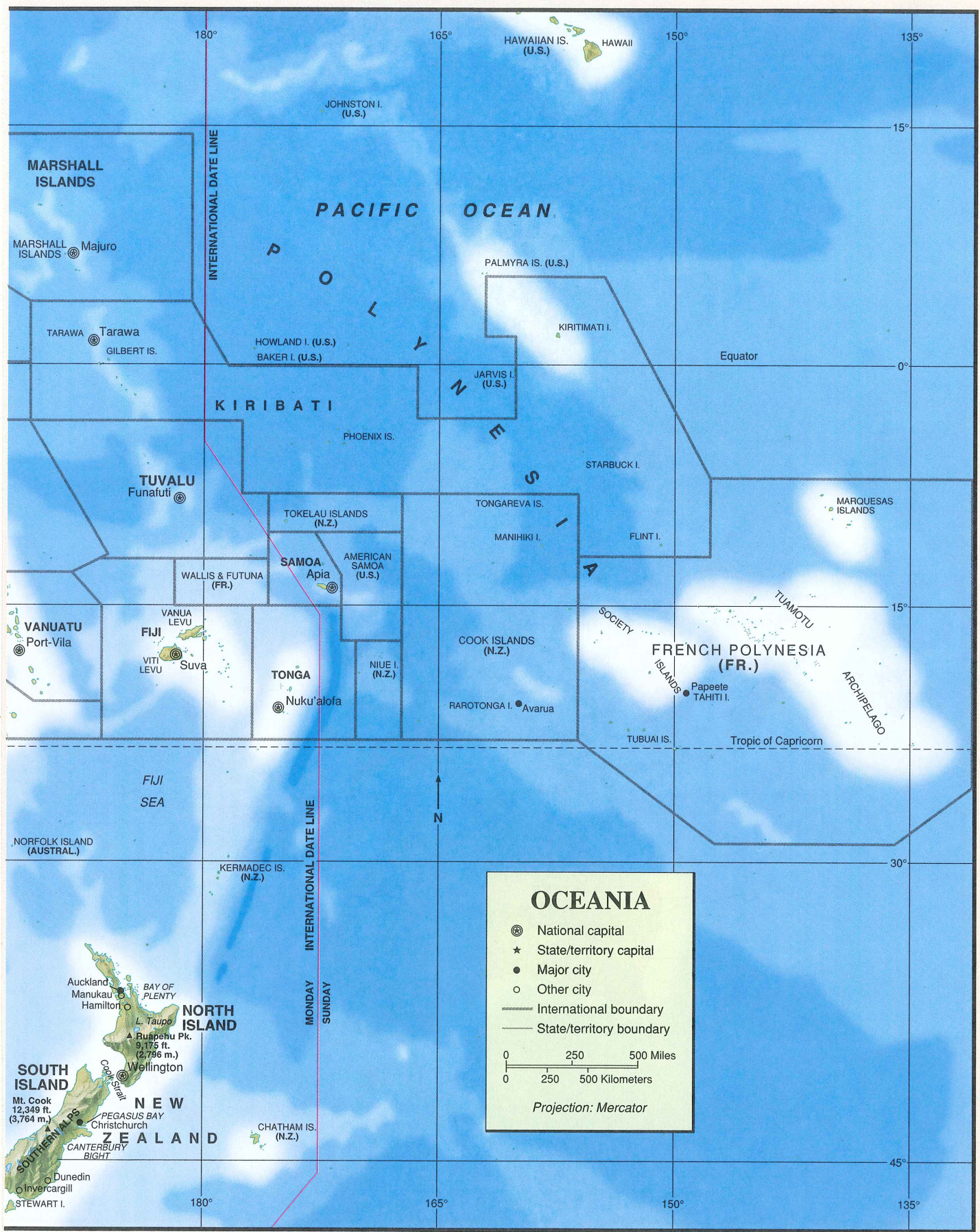


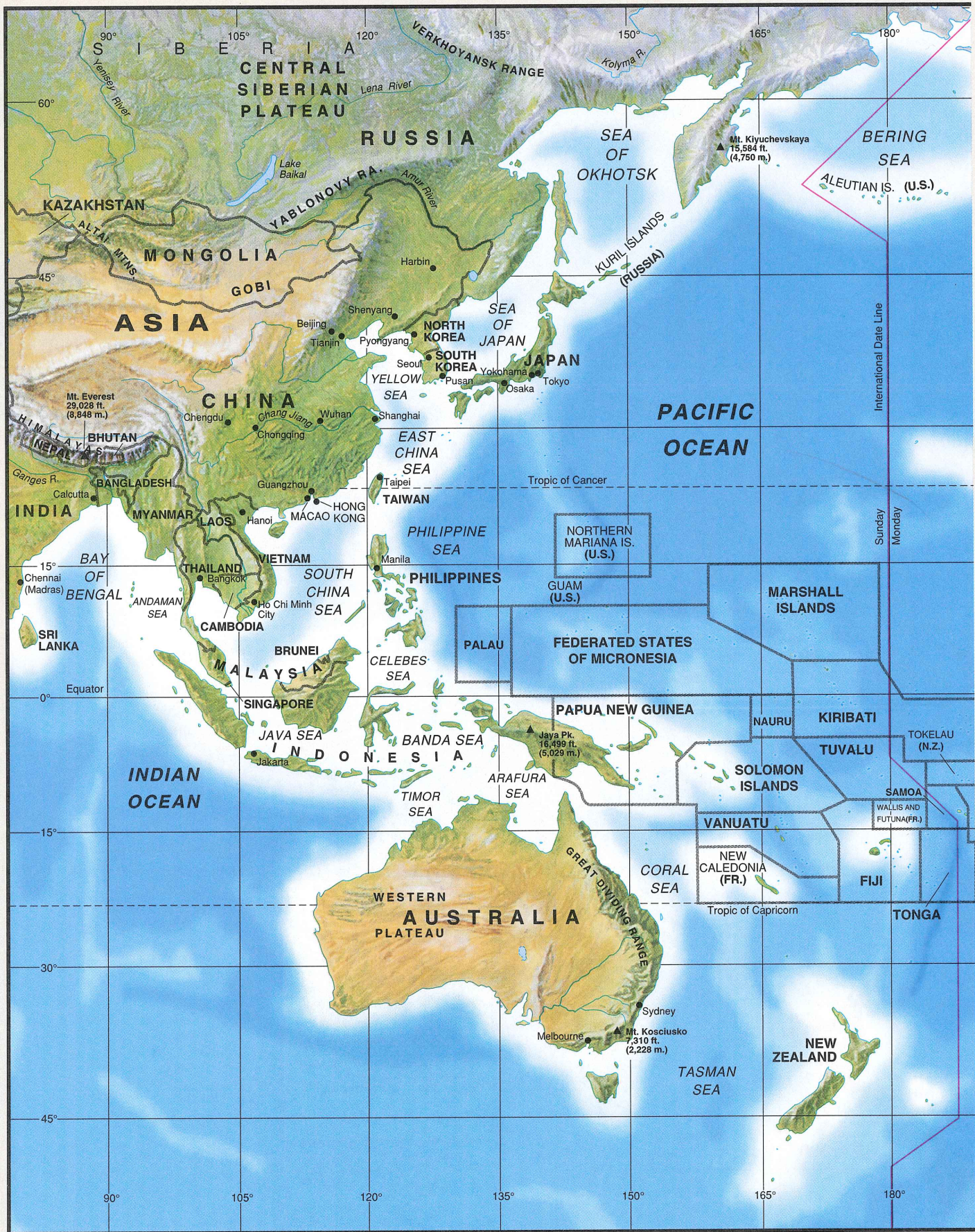




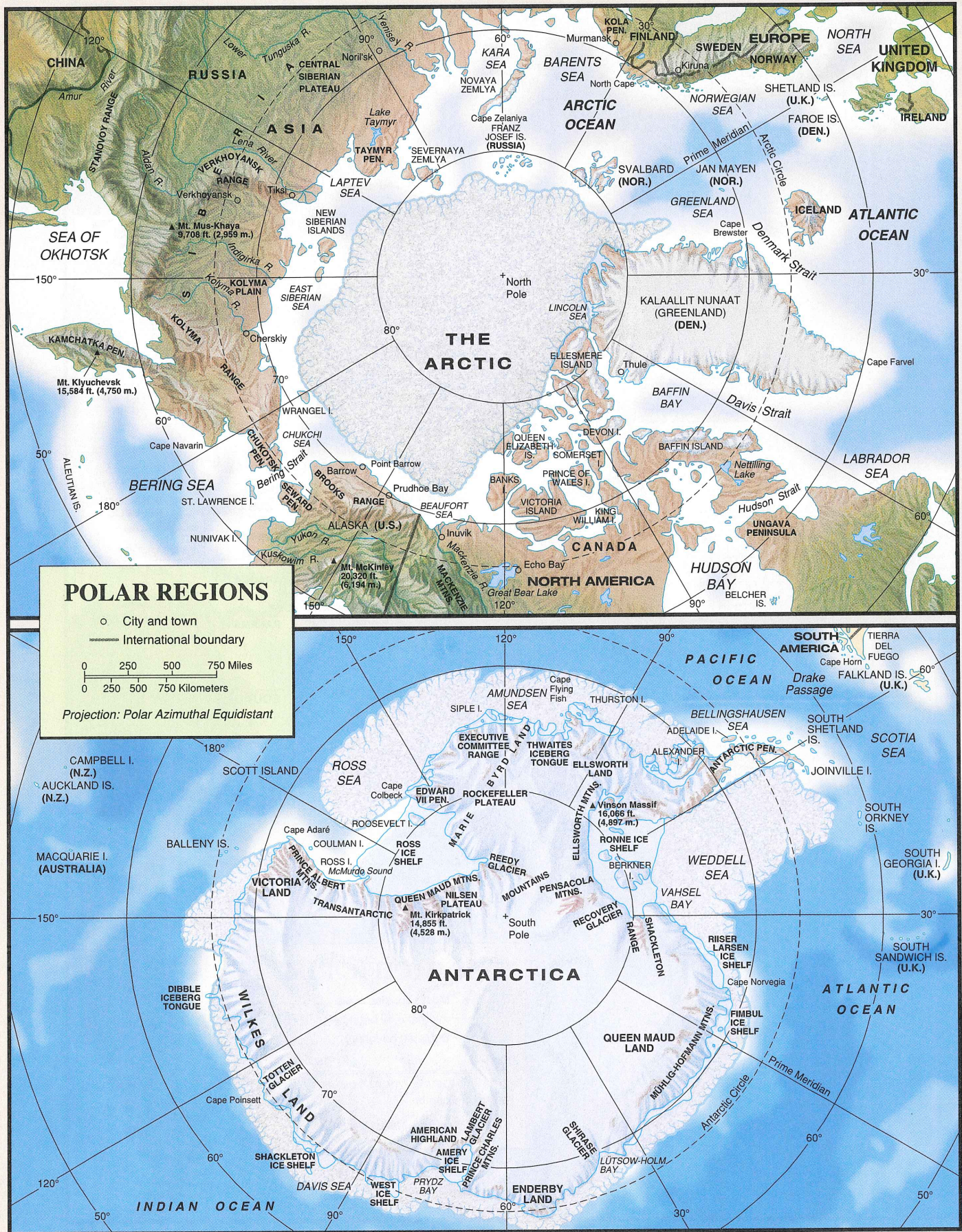
